The charm of this city resides in the historic, artistic and cultural heritage. The Etruscan Republican and Imperial remains, the early Christian churches, the Medieval and Renaissance buildings, the baroque basilicas are expression of a glorious past.

You can discover the flavour of the past visiting the magnificently preserved remains of the ancient port of Rome, Ostia, or loose yourself amid a theatre of breathtaking monuments, wandering through the Colosseum or the ruins of the Roman Forum, visiting the PANTHEON, CASTEL ST. ANGELO, ST. PETER BASILICA, or also the superlative SISTINE CHAPEL, the VATICAN MUSEUMS and finally throwing a coin in the TREVI FOUNTAIN immortalized by Federico Fellini in "LA DOLCE VITA".

You can admire the masterpieces of artists like MICHELANGELO, BERNINI, CARAVAGGIO, RAFFAELLO, BORROMINI.



Rome means unforgettable images: as the view of the monuments reflected on the Tevere along the LUNGOTEVERE or also the vision of the city from the JANICULUM HILL at dawn, or from the QUIRINALE or the PINCIO HILLS or also from the top of the Spanish steps at sunset.

It is worth strolling through popular piazzas, like PIAZZA DEL POPOLO, PIAZZA NAVONA, PIAZZA DI SPAGNA, or broad green areas, walking through parks and Villas from VILLA BORGHESE to VILLA PAMPHILI and being captured by the exciting atmosphere of the famous PORTA PORTESE market.

It is not possible to leave Rome without tasting the Roman traditional cuisine and experiencing the charm of the city by night between CAMPO DEI FIORI and TRASTEVERE.





Not to miss

Here are some of the places and monuments we highly recommend not to miss:

☞ **COLOSSEO** Its true name is Anfiteatro Flavio where the gladiators performed fights among themselves. It was built in 72 A. D. by Vespasian and finished eight years after by his son Titus.

☞ **THE VATICAN** Small and strong state inside Rome, bordering by the collonato di S. Pietro, via di Porta Angelica, Piazza Risorgimento, via Leone IV, via Della Sacrestia and viale Vaticano.

☞ **BASILICA DI SAN PIETRO IN VATICANO** Situated in Città del Vaticano, the residence of Popes since 1377, was built by Costantino, the first christian emperor and dedicated to the apostle Peter. After the building of the new Basilica decided by Pope Nicola V, and carried out by his successors, the most important architects and artists, who took part in it, were: Bramante, Raphael, Michelangelo, Bernini, Borromini, Giacomo della Porta, Domenico Fontana.

☞ **FORI IMPERIALI** It is here that the Roman civilization began and evolved throughout the centuries. The magnificence of its public buildings, constructed by various successive Emperors in command, were and are, the evidence of a great civilization.

☞ **TERME DI CARACALLA** The Baths of Caracalla are the best-preserved imperial baths in the city.

☞ **PANTHEON** Marcus Agrippa's Pantheon is one of the world's most magnificent architectural creations built in 27 BC, and rebuilt by Emperor Adrian in 120 A. D. a perfectly proportioned dome on an elegant drum of columns and pediments.

☞ **PIRAMIDE CESTIA (CAIO CESTIO'S PYRAMID)** In this pyramid, built in only 330 days, Caio Cestio was buried in 12 b. C.

☞ **CASTEL SANT'ANGELO** Built by the emperor Adrian as his mausoleum, later became a papal fortress and is linked by underground passages to the Vatican palaces.

☞ **COSTANTINE'S ARCH** This monument is the largest and best-preserved Roman triumphal arch. It was erected to commemorate Costantine's victory in 315 a.C.

☞ **PIAZZA NAVONA** This piazza, which follows the plan of an ancient circus, was built in monumental style by the family of Pope Innocent X (Pamphili). Here there are three magnificent fountains. The one in the centre is the Fountain of the Four Rivers by Bernini. The church of S. Agnese in Agone is a magnificent Baroque building designed by G. Rainaldi and Borromini. Beneath it there are some remains of the original church and of the Circus of Domitian.

☞ **PIAZZA DI SPAGNA** Piazza at the foot of the Spanish Steps, also known as the "Scalinata della Trinita dei Monti". The design of the steps was finished by Francesco de Sanctis after generations of controversy. The church at the top of the Steps is the Trinita dei Monti, founded by the French in 1495.

☞ **TREVI FOUNTAIN** The most famous fountain in Rome built by the architect Salvi who made it in 1735 under Clemente II's pontificate. The sculptured marble figures of the Fountain make it a true masterpiece both of sculpture and of architecture.

☞ **VILLA ADRIANA (TIVOLI)** Villa Adriana, an exceptional complex of classical buildings created in the 2nd century A. D. by the Roman Emperor Adrian, reproduces the best elements of the material cultures of Egypt, Greece, and Rome in the form of an "ideal city".

☞ **VILLA D'ESTE (TIVOLI)** Its innovative design and the architectural components in the garden (fountains, ornamental basins, etc.) make this a unique example of an Italian 16th-century garden.

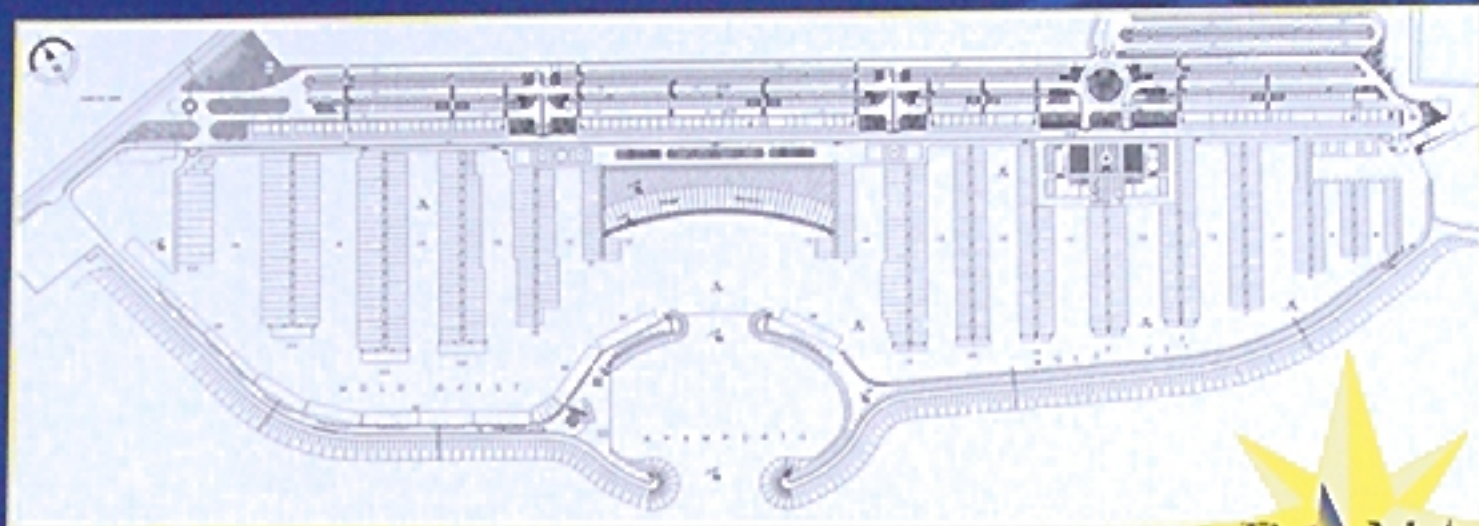
